#### **Our Commitment**

- **Diversity**: the presence of a wide range of identities, backgrounds, experiences and perspectives.
- **Inclusion**: fostering a culture of belonging where everyone is encouraged to contribute and thrive.

### **Guiding Principles**

- CAPhO integrates EDI considerations into policies, governance, learning activities and communications, whenever possible.
- CAPhO aims to reflect the diversity of our community in volunteer roles, presenters, and award and grant recipients.
- CAPhO is committed to continuous learning and reflection to ensure our practices are culturally safe, inclusive and responsive.
- CAPhO supports equitable access to professional development, funding and recognition within the scope of oncology pharmacy in Canada.
